Please find enclosed response from Glasgow City Council, Development and Regeneration Services, regarding the Scottish Parliament petition on shared space schemes.

Glasgow City Council recognises the need for a safe urban environment to serve the accessibility needs of the visually and mobility impaired and all members of the community. The Council endeavours to take these considerations into account in the design of the urban environment.

In the Council are asked to consider a shared space project, it is considered on its individual merits where we are aware of the need for a safe space within a shared space. Within residential developments the concept of shared surfaces are only considered within very lightly trafficked roads where the people driving on a road would also live on that road.
