5. Land and Buildings Transaction Tax (Scotland) Bill: The Committee considered the delegated powers provisions in this Bill at Stage 1 and agreed to seek further information from the Scottish Government.

- 6. **Public Service Pensions Bill (UK Parliament legislation):** The Committee considered the powers to make subordinate legislation conferred on Scottish Ministers in the Public Service Pensions Bill (UK Parliament legislation) and agreed not to report.
- 7. **Scottish Law Commission reports:** The Committee considered the evidence given by the Convener to the Standards, Procedures and Public Appointments Committee on this issue.
- 8. **Annual reports (in private):** The Committee received an update on issues raised recently with the Scottish Government and agreed to write to the Minister for Parliamentary Business.
