Amendment to the Air Weapons Bill

Mr Lyle reported that he had received a wording amendment from the Bill Team, that if supported would exempt travelling funfairs from the 1982 civic Government act.

after section 67, insert-<public entertainment licenses: exemption for funfairs, in section 41 of the 1982 Act (public entertainment licenses), after subsection (2)(aa) insert-"(ab) premises used for the purpose of a funfair;".>

Mr Lyle is to present his amendment next week (if not hindered by additional amendments to the act). The Scottish Section CPG are invited to sit in the Gallery. Mr Mason was worried about lack of consultation and the view that we are taking powers away from LAs.
