If you give your views by BSL video, both your video and the written English translation will normally be published on the Scottish Parliament website. Please tell us if you do not want your video published.

For legal reasons, please don't include in your video any defamatory content or information that could identify another person without their consent. If you do, we may ask you to make changes and resubmit your video.
