As you are aware the Committee has agreed to monitor the implementation and delivery of the devolved taxes. The Committee would, therefore, welcome an update from you on the performance of Revenue Scotland in administering and collecting the devolved taxes since 1 April 2015. This should include:

- provision of the latest outturn figures;
- level of compliance activity and details of compliance yield;
- update on staffing levels and running costs;
- details of performance against the Adam Smith principles and your strategic objectives as set out in the Revenue Scotland corporate plan.
