**1. Coronavirus (Extension and Expiry) (Scotland) Bill - Stage 2:** The Bill was considered at Stage 2 by a Committee of the Whole Parliament.

The following amendments were agreed to (without division): 13, 14 and 15.

Amendment 8 was agreed to (by division: For 62, Against 59, Abstentions 0).

The following amendments were disagreed to (by division)—

- 2 (For 55, Against 65, Abstentions 0)
- 3 (For 54, Against 66, Abstentions 0)
- 11 (For 33, Against 88, Abstentions 0)
- 12 (For 54, Against 66, Abstentions 0)
- 20 (For 55, Against 67, Abstentions 0)
- 22 (For 33, Against 88, Abstentions 0).

The following amendments were moved and, no member having objected, withdrawn: 1, 4, 5, 17, 18, 25.

The following amendments were not moved: 6, 7, 9, 10, 16, 19, 21, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30.

The following provisions were agreed to without amendment: sections 1 and 3 the schedule, sections 5, 6, 7 and the long title.

Section 2 was agreed to as amended.

The Committee completed Stage 2 consideration of the Bill.

The meeting closed at 6.56 pm.
