Meeting of the Parliament

Thursday 24 June 2021

The meeting opened at 12.00 pm.

1. First Minister's Questions: Questions were answered by the First Minister (Nicola Sturgeon).

2. Revision to Business Programme: The Minister for Parliamentary Business (George Adam), on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau, moved S6M-00503—That the Parliament agrees to the following revision to the programme of business for Thursday 24 June 2021—

The motion was agreed to.

3. Ministerial Statement: The Minister for Public Health, Women's Health and Sport (Maree Todd) made a statement and answered questions on Cervical Screening.

4. Coronavirus (Extension and Expiry) (Scotland) Bill - Stage 3: The Bill was considered at Stage 3.

The following amendments were agreed to (without division): 1, 2, 3, 4, 5A, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 17.

Amendment 14 was agreed to (by division: For 61, Against 60, Abstentions 0).

The following amendments were disagreed to (by division)—

- 11 (For 30, Against 90, Abstentions 0)
- 12 (For 59, Against 61, Abstentions 0)
- 13 (For 59, Against 61, Abstentions 0).

The following amendments were not moved: 5B and 7.

The Presiding Officer determined, under Rule 9.8.5BA, that, in her view, no provision of the Coronavirus (Extension and Expiry) (Scotland) Bill related to a protected subject-matter.

5. Coronavirus (Extension and Expiry) (Scotland) Bill: The Deputy First Minister and Cabinet Secretary for Covid Recovery (John Swinney) moved S6M-00479—That the Parliament agrees that the Coronavirus (Extension and Expiry) (Scotland) Bill be passed.

After debate, the motion was agreed to ((DT) by division: For 90, Against 32, Abstentions 0).

6. Scottish Commission for Public Audit: Maggie Chapman, on behalf of the Scottish Parliamentary Corporate Body, moved S6M-00505—That the Parliament agrees to the Scottish Parliamentary Corporate Body's proposal to appoint Daniel Johnson, Colin Beattie, Sharon Dowey and Mark Ruskell to be members of the Scottish Commission for Public Audit.

The motion was agreed to (DT).

7. Designation of Lead Committee: The Minister for Parliamentary Business (George Adam), on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau, moved S6M-00492—That the Parliament agrees that the Social Justice and Social Security Committee be designated as the lead committee in consideration of the Carer's Allowance Supplement (Scotland) Bill at stage 1.

The motion was agreed to (DT).

8. Motion Without Notice: The Minister for Parliamentary Business and Veterans (Graeme Dey), on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau, moved without notice that, under Rule 11.2.4, Decision Time be brought forward to 5.13 pm.

The motion was agreed to.
