COMMITTEE CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT CLIMATE CHANGE PLAN (RPP3)

Thank you for your letter of 30 September outlining the Environment, Climate Change and Land Reform Committee's proposals for scrutiny of the draft RPP3.

I have discussed the matter with the Rural Economy and Connectivity Committee members and we agree that a collaborative approach is the best way forward.
