Scottish Government Climate Change Plan (RPP3)

At its meeting on 7 December, the Rural Economy and Connectivity Committee agreed its approach to scrutiny of the Scottish Government's upcoming Climate Change Plan (RPP3).

The Committee agreed to focus its scrutiny of the draft RPP3 on matters related to transport, agriculture and forestry (subject to any revision required once the report has been laid).
