The meeting opened at 10.00 am.

1. **Decisions on taking business in private:** The Committee agreed to take items 4 and 5 in private.
2. **Management of Offenders (Scotland) Bill:** The Committee considered the Bill at Stage 2 (Day 3).

Amendment 127 was agreed to (by division: For 8, Against 1, Abstentions 0).

The following amendments were disagreed to (by division)—

130 (For 3, Against 6, Abstentions 0)
133 (For 2, Against 7, Abstentions 0)
76A (For 3, Against 6, Abstentions 0).

Amendment 76 was moved and, no member having objected, withdrawn.

The following amendments were not moved: 72, 80, 68, 69 and 70.

The following provisions were agreed to without amendment: sections 48 and 49.

The long title was agreed to as amended.

The Committee completed Stage 2 consideration of the Bill.

3. **Justice Sub-Committee on Policing:** The Committee noted a report back from the Convener of the Sub-Committee on the meeting held on 4 April 2019.
4. **Brexit subordinate legislation (in private):** The Committee considered a draft report. Various changes were agreed to and the Committee agreed its report to the Parliament.
5. **Work programme (in private):** The Committee considered its work programme and noted items of business currently scheduled for consideration in May and June 2019.
